MIKE MATHENY: Mike Matheny last season became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history... in his first year at the helm in 2012, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Championship round of the playoffs, having captured the 2nd Wild Card berth on the next-to-last day of the regular season...he became the first rookie manager to lead the Cardinals to the postseason since Eddie Dyer in 1946...he won his 100th career game on Apr. 23, 2013, at Washington in his 182nd game...Matheny had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252) and for consecutive errorless chances (1,565).

THIS DATE IN STL HISTORY: On this date in 1966 Busch Memorial Stadium opened with its first game, a STL 4-3 win in 12 innings over the Atlanta Braves...Mike Shannon hit the first Cardinals home run in the new park and Lou Brock won the game with a walk-off RBI single.

❑ **RUNDOWN:** The 2012 Wild Card Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in their 122nd season of play in the National League...the team has a 10-day homestand currently playing three vs. COL (2-0), four vs. NYM and three vs. MIL... the Cardinals concluded a six-game road trip Wed. going 5-1 at MIL (4-0) & CHI (1-1)...St. Louis enters today with the top record in the Major Leagues at 23-12 and have won nine of their last 10 games.

❑ **DOUBLE TROUBLE:** On the heels of Shelby Miller's one-hit shutout win on Friday night, yesterday Adam Wainwright twirled a two-hit shutout, holding the Rockies hitless through 7.1 innings...it marks just the 5th time in Cardinals franchise history starting pitchers have had consecutive complete games with two hits or less...the last time it happened was May 2-3, 1967 when Bob Gibson and Ray Washburn each allowed two hits in complete game wins vs. CIN (also occurred in 1927, '42 and '46).

❑ **ROTATION COMPILATION:** Cardinals starting pitchers have compiled a Major League best 2.11 ERA over 35 starts (Tigers 2nd, 3.27) with an MLB best 21-7 record...as a staff, Cardinals pitchers have posted the best ERA in MLB at 2.89 (Rangers 3.29), which ranks as the 10th best in franchise history and the lowest since the 2010 pitching staff had a 2.74 ERA after this many games (35)...the seven shutouts through 35 rank 2nd all-time in STL history to eight in 1944, while the 278 strikeouts top the pitching core of any team in franchise history (2012 staff 2nd with 258) through 35 games. **SHRINKING ERA:** Following Shelby Miller's 1.58 ERA (2nd), Jake Westbrook ranks 4th among National League pitchers with a 1.62 ERA, today's starter Jaime Garcia is 8th at 2.25, Adam Wainwright comes in 9th lowering his ERA yesterday to 2.30, with Lance Lynn at 2.72 (18th).

❑ **RAGING BULLPEN:** Since May 3, the Cardinals bullpen has the lowest ERA (0.73) in MLB allowing one run on seven hits over 12.1 innings with the opposition hitting .189, while stranding 9-of-10 inherited runners.

❑ **HOLLIDAY VS. ROCKIES:** Matt Holliday, who was drafted by Colorado in 1998, made his ML debut and played five seasons with the club, is a career .374 hitter when facing his former team (8HR, 23 RBI in 26 games)...last season Matt blasted five home runs with 16 RBI in seven games while hitting .481 against the Rockies.

❑ **MAY-FLYERS:** The Cardinals have put together the best May batting average in MLB, hitting .313 on 99 hits in nine May contests...Tampa Bay Rays are 2nd with a .296 team average.
