MIKE MATHENY: Mike Matheny last season became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history...in his first year at the helm in 2012, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Championship round of the playoffs, having captured the 2nd Wild Card berth on the next-to-last day of the regular season...he became the first rookie manager to lead the Cardinals to the postseason since Eddie Dyer in 1946...he won his 100th career game on Apr. 23, 2013, at Washington in his 182nd game...Matheny had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252) and for consecutive errorless chances (1,565).

THIS DATE IN STL HISTORY, 1968: Steve Carlton hurled 8.0 innings of 2-hit ball and Roger Maris went 3-for-3 as St. Louis defeated Philadelphia 2-1 at Connie Mack Stadium. The Cardinals move to 71-44, 27 games over .500, their high mark of the season (.664) en route to their 12th National League pennant.

REDBIRD RUNDOWN: The 2012 N.L. Wild Card Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in their 122nd season of play in the National League...the Cardinals are 18 games over .500, residing 2.5 games back of the first place Pittsburgh Pirates, after the Bucco's have won the first four games of this series...the Cardinals' next opponent, the Cincinnati Reds are 3.5 games behind STL...when the Cards lost both games of the doubleheader on Tuesday, it was the first time dropping both games in a DH since 1996, snapping a streak of 22 DH played without being swept, which had been the longest active stretch in baseball (Elias).

A SWEEP WE'D RATHER NOT SEE: St. Louis is in danger of being swept during this five-game series with the Pirates, something that hasn't happened in quite a while...the last time the Cardinals were swept in a 5-game set occurred when the team lost a six-games series September 23-27, 1916 by the New York Giants at the Polo Grounds.

TURN THIS THING AROUND: The Cardinals have lost seven straight, the first time the team has dropped seven in a row since doing so during their World Championship run in 2011...6/10-17/2011 the Cardinals lost three at Milwaukee, three in Washington D.C. and a final game vs. Kansas City. **TO WIN YOU HAVE TO RUN:** The Cardinals six-straight losses from 7/26-7/30 came as the team scored two runs or less in each loss, just the fourth time that has occurred in franchise history - the last August of 1957 (8/9-15).

COACH, I GOT THIS: The Cardinals are hitting an MLB-best .333 with runners in scoring position...according to Elias that .333 clip would be the best average with RISP in over 50 years and is so far ahead of the next-best team (.294 Detroit Tigers), that the Redbirds could go hitless in their next 131 at-bats with RISP and still lead the Majors...they could also go hitless in their next 235 at-bats with RISP and still lead the National League...the Cardinals have five of the top nine hitters in the National League with runners in scoring position: **Allen Craig** .465 (1st), **Matt Carpenter** .400 (3rd), **Yadier Molina** .383 (5th), **Carlos Beltran** .367 and **Matt Holiday** .365...Craig leads the Majors which would be the best mark for a season since George Brett hit .469 in 1980.

LONG GONE: The 68 home runs allowed by Cardinals pitchers are their fewest allowed in first 106 games since 1990 (58)...the Cardinals themselves have hit 83 home runs in first 106 games, the team's fewest since 1995 (75).

JOE KELLY • RHP • 6-1 • 175 • 24 yrs • #58

⇒ Will make his 5th start of 2013 season and the 21st of his young career. He made 16 starts for the Cardinals in 2012.
 ⇒ His 4 starts this season: 7/27 at ATL (ND, 6.1P OR), 7/12 at CHI (W, 5.1P R), 7/6 vs. MIA (ND, 6.0P 4ER) & 6/5 vs. ARI (L 5.2IP, 1ER).
 ⇒ Pitched 6.1 scoreless frames last Sat. (7/27) at Atlanta. Gave up 7 hits, walked 3 and fanned 3 in his start, Cards lost 2-0.
 ⇒ His start at ATL was his first outing since before the ASB. Picked up his first win of the season at Chicago on 7/12 after allowing the Cubs only a single run on 3 hits, walking 2 and fanning 4 through 5.1 ings.
 ⇒ Has faced the Pirates three times in relief this season. Pitched 2.0 scoreless 4/15, 1.0 scoreless 4/26 & got the loss in 0.1 IP 4/27 (4R).
 ⇒ Last season faced PIT twice, including 5.2 innings of relief during the club's 19-inning game. Joe allowed one run, but did not get a decision in 6-3 loss. He also started a game on 8/29 at PIT (5IP, 5R).
 ⇒ Has 21 relief apps. this year - last on 6/28 at OAK when he logged 5.1 relief IP allowing one run (Shelby Miller start just 1.2IP).
 ⇒ Worked 5.0 Sho relief IP on 6/21 vs. TEX. Has allowed just 2 ER in his last 7 relief appearances (19.2 IP) for a 0.92 ERA.
 ⇒ Started 3 games this spring in competition for the final starter's spot in the rotation. Allowed 3R (2ER) in 8.0 IP in spring starts.
 ⇒ Began 2012 in Memphis, had 12 starts before promotion to STL.
 ⇒ Made his Major League debut 6/10/12 vs. CLE (ND, 5.0 IP, R, 7H).
 ⇒ Ranked T5th among NL rookies last year w/107.0 IP & T9 w/75 K's.
 ⇒ Had six scoreless outings (7.0 IP) during the 2012 postseason before allowing two runs in Game 7 of the NLCS at SF.

 ⇒ The first Major League start of his career was against the Reds on the last day of the 2012 season (10/3). Shelby carried a no-hitter into the sixth inning before allowing a single. He went 6.0 IP, allowed just the one hit, BBed 2, struck out 7 in no decision (Cards won 1-0).
 ⇒ Recorded 2 hits in his start at ATL 7/28, his 2nd 2-hit game this yr. Left his start tied 2-2 after 5.2, but got the loss in the 5-2 game.
 ⇒ Is 4-5, 3.98 ERA on the road this year (10 GS) vs. 6-2, 1.74 ERA at home (also 10 starts).
 ⇒ Ranks 10th in the National League in ERA at 2.79.
