



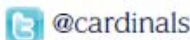

MIKE MATHENY: Mike Matheny last season became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history...in his first year at the helm in 2012, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Championship round of the playoffs, having captured the 2nd Wild Card berth on the next-to-last day of the regular season...he became the first rookie manager to lead the Cardinals to the postseason since Eddie Dyer in 1946...he won his 100th career game on Apr. 23, 2013, at Washington in his 182nd game...Matheny had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252) and for consecutive errorless chances (1,565).

THIS DATE IN STL HISTORY, 1998: Ray Lankford stole the show during the Great Home Run Chase, hitting a three-run home run off Greg Maddux in the 6th inning as the Cardinals held on to win 3-2 at Turner Field. It was the last time Maddux threw a complete game with nine or more strikeouts and lost, in a career that would last 10 more years.

REDBIRD RUNDOWN: The 2012 N.L. Wild Card Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in their 122nd season of play in the National League...the Cardinals are 19 games over .500, residing 1.5 games back of the first place Pittsburgh Pirates, after the Bucco's swept both games of a doubleheader yesterday...the Cardinals' next opponent, the Cincinnati Reds are 4.5 games behind STL and 6.0 games out of first in the N.L. Central.

TURN THIS THING AROUND: The Cardinals have lost six straight, the first time the team has dropped six in a row since dropping seven straight during their World Championship run in 2011...6/10-17/2011 the Cardinals lost three at Milwaukee, three in Washington D.C. and then a final game vs. Kansas City. **TO WIN YOU HAVE TO RUN:** The Cardinals six-straight losses have come scoring two runs or less...that has happened just four times in franchise history - the last coming in August of 1957 (8/9-15).

END OF AN ERROR: Jon Jay was charged with a fielding error in Game 1 of the doubleheader yesterday, allowing Sterling Marte to advance to second base on a single to center...it was Jay's first error since August 24, 2011 - a span of 245 errorless games...he now holds the longest errorless streak for a Cardinals outfielder, as he surpassed Curt Flood's 226 game streak from 9/3/65 to 6/2/67.

TRIPLE TRIPLES: The Pittsburgh Pirates legged out three triples in Game 2 yesterday...the last time St. Louis allowed three triples in a game was June 2, 1999 at Florida when Preston Wilson, Bruce Aven and Luis Castillo ran out three baggers...St. Louis has only allowed three triples in a game 38 times since 1919.

THIS HURTS: St. Louis will place catcher **Yadier Molina** on the 15-day disabled list today with a right knee sprain, as well as outfielder **Shane Robinson** with a right shoulder strain...the team will recall outfielders **Adron Chambers** and **Brock Peterson** to join the team in Pittsburgh for tonight's game...this will be Peterson's second time with the team (5 games, 1-7) and Chamber's first time this season.

JUMP ON MY BACK: Cardinals starter tonight **Adam Wainwright** leads the pitching staff, as well as all National League hurlers, with 13 wins...five of his wins for the Redbirds have come following team losses.

LONG GONE: The 67 home runs allowed by Cardinals pitchers are their fewest allowed in first 105 games since 1990 (58)...the Cardinals themselves have hit 83 home runs in first 105 games, the team's fewest since 1995 (75).

ADAM WAINWRIGHT • RHP • 6-7 • 228 • 31 yrs • #50

- ⇒ Makes his team-leading 23rd start & 16th career start (20th game) vs. the Pirates. It will be his first start facing PIT this season.
- ⇒ Is 8-4 in his 15 previous starts (19 gms) against PIT, and 5-2 in his last seven games facing the Pirates since August 2009. Holds a lofty 5-1 record over eight starts (10 gms) at PNC Park.
- ⇒ His last appearance at PNC came on 8/24/10, a 4-3 loss.
- ⇒ Selected to his 2nd All-Star Game (also 2010), voted in by players.
- ⇒ Voted NL Pitcher of the Month for June; 4-2, 1.77 ERA in 6 GS.
- ⇒ Got the loss in his last start at ATL, 7/26, 4-1. Allowed all four runs (3ER) over 7.0 IP.
- ⇒ Became the NL's 1st 13-game winner with 3-2 victory vs. SD 7/21.
- ⇒ Tops in NL in IP (161.2), 1st in wins (13), 5th in ERA (2.51), 4th in strikeouts (145), 1st in BB/9 IP (1.00), 2nd in HR/9 IP (0.39), 1st CG (4) and T1st in ShO (2).
- ⇒ Walked just 18 batters, fewest among NL starters w/100+ IP; he's had eight starts w/0 BBs.
- ⇒ Recorded 1,000 career strikeout 6/13 at NYM (D.Wright) in 1st inn.
- ⇒ Was the first N.L. pitcher to 10 wins, doing so at NYM on 6/13.
- ⇒ Didn't walk a batter in first 34.2 IP to start season. Since 1900 is 2nd longest STL streak: Slim Sallee in 1913, no walks in 1st 40.0 IP.
- ⇒ Pitched a CG 4-hit shutout with 12 K's vs. MIL on 4/13. Became 1st Cards pitcher since Bob Gibson (6/17/70) to pitch CG shutout w/a K in every inning as Adam fanned 12 (tied career high).
- ⇒ Signed largest contract by STL pitcher (5 yrs, 2014-18) on 3/28.
