**MIKE MATHENY:** Mike Matheny last season became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history... in his first year at the helm in 2012, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Championship round of the playoffs, having captured the 2nd Wild Card berth on the next-to-last day of the regular season...he became the first rookie manager to lead the Cardinals to the postseason since Eddie Dyer in 1946...he won his 100th career game on Apr. 23, 2013, at Washington in his 182nd game...Matheny had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252) and for consecutive errorless chances (1,565).

**THIS DATE IN STL HISTORY:** Mike Shannon's SF scoring Joe Torre caps a 4-run 8th inning as STL rallied from 3-0 deficit to defeat Montreal 6-3 at Olympic Stadium. It was Shannon's last 7/5 game as a player. Bob Gibson threw a CG.

**REDBIRD RUNDOWN:** The 2012 N.L. Wild Card Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in their 122nd season of play in the National League...the Cardinals allowed three runs in the bottom of the 9th last night in a 6-5 walk-off loss, to end the 8-game interleague roadtrip 3-5 (1-1 HOU, 1-2 OAK, 1-2 LAA)...the Redbirds will play five games in six days during this homestand with three facing Miami, an open day on Monday and play their final two interleague games on Tuesday and Wednesday vs. the Houston Astros.

**FIRST HALF NUMBERS:** The Cardinals posted 49 wins thru their first 81 games, their best start since 2005 at the mid-way point...they won 51 thru 81 games in 2005 and a record 56 in 1944...the Cardinals are a season-high 2.0 games back of 1st place...they held sole possession of 1st place from April 30 to June 25 and held a season-high 4.0 game lead as recently as June 9...St. Louis leads the majors with a +117 run differential.

**WAINWRIGHT VOTED N.L. PITCHER OF MONTH:** Adam Wainwright was voted the National League Pitcher of the Month for June...Adam posted a 4-2 record in June, leading the majors with 45.2 innings pitched and tying for the N.L. lead in wins...he allowed just nine earned runs in his six outings, posting a 1.77 ERA, which was the fourth-lowest mark among qualifying N.L. starters...it is the first career monthly award for Wainwright and the first Pitcher of the Month honor for a Cardinals hurler since Chris Carpenter won in August 2009.

**CENTERPIECE:** Jon Jay owns the NL's longest active errorless streak (227 games/534 chances) for centerfielders dating back to his last error on Aug. 24, 2011...his 227-game errorless streak is the longest streak all-time among Cardinals outfielders, surpassing Curt Flood's 226 game streak from 9/3/65 to 6/2/67.

**BAT PACK:** The Cardinals have three players (Molina, Carpenter, Craig) who rank among the NL's top-10 in batting...Craig (.469) and Beltran (.456) rank 1-2 in NL batting w/RISP...Craig finished T2nd in June NL RBI (26) behind Nationals Ian Desmond (28)...Craig is 2nd in NL RBI (66) and was first STL batter since Tom Herr in 1985 (66 RBI, 3 HR) to have that many RBI with less than 10 HR's thru 81 games (Craig 63RBI thru 81 Gs)...Molina (106), Carpenter (104) & Craig (102) are all in the NL top-5 in hits...Molina has an NL leading 26 doubles...Carpenter leads the NL with 34 multi-hit games.

**SIZZLING SOUTHPAW:** Rookie reliever Kevin Siegrist has been unscored upon in his first 11 career games (11.0 IP), the longest streak to begin a career by a Cards LH reliever since Tyler Johnson posted 11-consecutive scoreless apps. (5.1 IP) to begin his career (2005-06)...Bryan Eversgerd was unscored upon in his first 12 Gs (16.0 IP) in 1994.

**JAKE WESTBROOK • RHP • 6-3 • 210 • 35 yrs • #35**

⇒ Makes his 11th start on the season, 5th since coming off DL.  
 ⇒ Will be 2nd start vs. MIA this season & 8th career start. He's 1-2, 3.00 ERA (45.0 IP/15 ER) in previous career starts vs. Marlins; 7 QS.  
 ⇒ Dropped 7-5 decision at OAK last Sun. (6/30); 4.0 IP, 10 H, 6 R.  
 ⇒ Posted a 13-5 win at HOU on 6/25, allowing 4 runs in 6.0 IP as he stretched his winning streak to four games vs. the Astros.  
 ⇒ Was on the disabled list with right elbow inflammation from 5/9-6/13, missing 33 games. Made 2 rehab starts: Springfield (AA) 3.2IP, 6H, R, 5K & Peoria (A) 7.0IP, 4H, R, 5K.  
 ⇒ Is 2-2, 5.32 ERA (22.0 IP/13 ER) in 4 GS since coming off the DL.  
 ⇒ Had an N.L.-leading 1.62 ERA at time of DL. His current 2.95 ERA is 22.0 innings shy of qualifying among league leaders.  
 ⇒ Did not allow a HR in his first 56.0 IP this season & has allowed just two HR's all season in 61.0 IP.  
 ⇒ Earned 100th career win 5/2 at MIL, 6-5 [6.0 IP, 6H, R, 4K].  
 ⇒ His ShO 4/10 vs. CIN was 1st since 8/9/06 vs. LAA while w/CLE.  
 ⇒ Since being acquired by Cardinals (7/31/10) is the MLB leader in ground ball pct (74.0) among starting pitchers.

⇒ Will make his 2nd start of 2013 season and the 18th of his young career. He made 16 starts for the Cardinals in 2012.  
 ⇒ Made his lone start of '13 on 6/5 vs. ARI, losing 10-3. Worked 5.2 IP, allowing just one earned run on 4 hits.  
 ⇒ Has 21 relief apps. this year including his most recent on 6/28 at OAK when he logged 5.1 relief IP, allowing just one run, after S. Miller was knocked from the game in the 2nd inning.  
 ⇒ Worked 5.0 ShO relief IP on 6/21 vs. TEX. Has allowed just 2 ER in last 7 appearances (19.2 IP) for a 0.92 ERA.  
 ⇒ Is unscored upon in 2 relief app. (1.2 IP) vs. MIA this season and has a 0-0, 1.32 career mark, making two starts, vs. Marlins in '12.
