



MIKE MATHENY: Mike Matheny last season became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history... in his first year at the helm in 2012, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Championship round of the playoffs, having captured the 2nd Wild Card berth on the next-to-last day of the regular season, he became the first rookie manager. ular season...he became the first rookie manager to lead the Cardinals to the postseason since Eddie Dyer in 1946...he won his 100th career game on Apr. 23, 2013, at Washington in his 182nd game...Matheny had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252) and for consecutive errorless chances (1,565). ular season...he became the first rookie manager secutive errorless chances (1.565).

THIS DATE IN STL HISTORY: Fernando Salas turns 28 today, a day after his teammate, Trevor Rosenthal, celebrated his 23rd birthday (May 29).

RUNDOWN: The 2012 N.L. Wild Card Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in their 122nd season of play in the National League...the Cardinals concluded an eight-game roadtrip Tuesday going 6-2 (2-1 at SD, 2-1 at LAD, 2-0 at KC)...St. Louis enters today with a Major League best 35-17 record.

A LOT OF CHOATE: Cardinals lefty relief specialist earned his first decision as a member of the Cardinals in last night's come-from-behind win...it was his first decision rendered since July 24, 2011 (vs. NYM while w/FLA), a span of 103 appearances...his 103 games without a decision is the 3rd longest streak of games pitched without a decision in MLB history behind Trever Miller (121 gms: April 2007-July 2008) & Bobby Seay (116 gms: Sept 2001-Aug 2007).

☐ INTERLEAGUE: The Cardinals are playing their first interleague games of the season during this week's MLB "rivalry" week with a pair of home-and-home two-game series against the Kansas City Royals...the Cardinals are scheduled to play a total 20 interleague games this season; <u>Home:</u> KC (2), TEX (3), HOU (2), SEA (3); <u>Road:</u> KC (2), HOU (2), OAK (3), LAA (3)...St. Louis was 8-7 (4-2 on the road) in interleague play last season, and the Cardinals are 127-110 (.534) all-time in interleague play, the top winning pct. amongst all NL teams...their best single-season interleague mark was 11-1 in 2004 & their worst mark was a 4-9 ledger in 1998.

QUICK RUN: When Miachael Wacha makes his Major League debut tonight, he will become the fastest Cardinals pitcher to make his debut following the draft since Cris Carpenter who was drafted in 1987 and made his debut on 5/14/88 vs. ATL...JD Drew was the quickest Cardinals player, making his debut in September of 1998 after being drafted in June earlier that same year.

☐ WACHA TAKES THE MOUND: RHP Michael Wacha was purchased today from Memphis (AAA) to make tonight's start vs. the Royals and RHP Michael Blazek was optioned to AAA...to make room on the 40-man roster. LHP Jaime Garcia was transferred to the 60-day DL...Wacha, 21, was the Cardinals #1 draft selection (19th player overall) last June out of Texas A & M University...the 6-6, 210-pound Texarkana, Texas native was 4-0 with a Pacific Coast Leagueleading 2.05 ERA in nine starts for Memphis...Wacha is the 8th rookie pitcher to appear on St. Louis' roster this season...the Cards have received a Major League-leading 12 wins from rookie pitchers this season.

☐ KIDDIE CORPS: With the addition of Wacha to the pitching staff, St. Louis has the youngest active rotation in MLB at 25 years...next youngest is the Rangers (25.8) with Arizona & Miami at 26.2...the Cardinals have used eight pitchers 25 years or younger...Wacha will become the 9th rookie to make his debut tonight for STL.

## TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

### MICHAEL WACHA • RHP • 6-6 • 210 • 21 yrs • #52

⇒Becomes the 3rd Cardinals pitcher to make his Major League debut in a start this season joining John Gast and Tyler Lyons.
⇒Was purchased from Memphis (AAA) today making him the fastest Cardinal pitcher to debut from draft since Cris Carpenter (drafted in

1987 and debuted 5/14/88).

⇒ Was 4-0 and leading the Pacific Coast League with a 2.05 ERA at the time of purchase. Opponents were batting .077 (2-26) w/RISP.

⇒ Has struck out 74 batters over 73.2 career minor league innings.

⇒ Has struck out /4 batters over /3.2 career minor league innings. 
⇒ Has not allowed more than three runs in any of his nine starts this season with five quality starts.

⇒ Memphis superlatives: Innings (7.0, 3 times, last at Tacoma 5/16); strikeouts (8, 5/16 at Tacoma); hits (6, at Salt Lake 5/21); runs (3, at Oklahoma City 4/13); pitches (105, vs. lowa 4/23).

⇒ The Cardinals first pick (19th overall) in the 2012 first-year player draft out of Texas A&M University.

⇒Making 2nd career start vs. SF. Earned win at AT&T Park on 4/6, tossing 5.1 IP allowing two runs on four hits in a Cardinals 6-3 win Received a no decision in last start at LAD (5/26) facing off vs. Clayton Kershaw. Threw 5.1 innings allowing three runs, Cards won 5-3. ⇒Has made five quality starts. Through the minors and majors, has recorded a quality start ever time he has thrown 6.0 IP or more (29). 
⇒Ranks T12th in NL in wins (5), 4th in ERA (2.02), 3rd in opp. BA (.201), 6th in WHIP (0.98) and 11th in K's (65).

⇒Retired 27 straight batters after allowing a leadoff hit in his start vs. COL (5/10) & tied STL rookie record with 13 K's in CG 1-hit ShO... was first since John Lackey ('06) w/27 straight outs after leadoff hit. ⇒ His 1.84 ERA in first 11 career qualifying starts (5.0+ IP) is best ever by Cards rookie thru first 11 career qualifying starts.
