TODAY'S GAME: The Cardinals are playing the final game of this series vs. the Atlanta Braves and are looking for their 1st sweep of the season and 1st sweep over the Braves since last July at Atlanta (7/26-28)...first pitch is 1:15 p.m. CDT today as all fans 15 and under will receive a 28" Matt Carpenter bat...the Braves are the first non-division opponents the Cardinals are facing at home this season...following the rainout Wednesday, the Cards are playing nine games this stand against Chicago Cubs (2-1), Atlanta (2-0) and Arizona (3)...the Cardinals are in a stretch of playing 18 of 21 games at home coming after a stretch of 20 out of 26 games on the road.

MIKE MATHENY: Mike Matheny, who in 2012 became the 49th manager in St. Louis Cardinals history, took his team to the World Series in his second season at the helm with a league-best 97-win season in 2013...in 2012, Mike guided the Cardinals to the N.L. Championship round of the playoffs...he is the first Cardinals manager to lead his teams to the postseason in each of his first two seasons, having already managed 30 postseason games in his first two seasons...Matheny, 43, had a 13-year Major League career playing with MIL, TOR, STL and SF, winning four Rawlings Gold Gloves ('00, '03-'05), and retiring from the game in 2006 due to concussion symptoms...he holds the M.L. catching record for consecutive errorless games (252) and for consecutive errorless chances (1,565)...he will serve as the N.L. Manager for this year's MLB All-Star Game in Minneapolis, MN.

BIRD WATCHING: The 2013 National League Champion St. Louis Cardinals are in their 123rd season of play in the National League...the Birds matched their longest win streak of the year at four with a 4-1 victory over Atlanta yesterday...the Cardinals mixed four infield hits and a triple by Matt Adams, along with a strong outing by Shelby Miller who allowed the one run (unearned) over 7.0 IP, fanning seven along the way.

ITTY-BITTY HITS: St. Louis played small ball yesterday managing four bunt hits, two pieces from Kolton Wong and Peter Bourjos...it was just the 2nd time this century and the first time since Detroit on 9/23/03 that a team had four bunt hits in a game...the only other time since 1980 a team had two players with two bunt hits each was Houston on 5/15/91 (Biggio & S.Finley)...the game marked just the 7th time in all of baseball a team had 4+ bunt hits in a game since 1980, aside from St. Louis and the afore mentioned Detroit and Houston games, the others were: 7/6/89 DET, 9/24/82 PIT, 9/12/80 OAK, 4/20/80 OAK.

GARCIA IS BACK: Lefthanded pitcher Jaime Garcia will make his first start today since having shoulder surgery to repair a torn labrum and rotator cuff in late May last season...his last Major League start was May 17 last year vs. MIL, a 7-6 win in which he pitched 5.1 innings allowing all six runs...Garcia made two rehab starts recently, one in Springfield (AA) allowing two runs in 2.0 innings before being hit by a pitch on his pitching elbow while batting in the 2nd, and in Memphis (AAA) where he went 5.0 innings (3H, 2R, HR, 2BB, 5K).

RBI MACHINE IN LEFTFIELD: Matt Holliday has a team best 24 RBI, 10 RBI shy of 1,000 for his career...he would become the 17th active player to reach that milestone...Holliday's RBI double Friday was the game-winning ribeye, giving him 7 GWRBI on the year, 2nd in the N.L. ...he has scored a run or picked up a hit in each of his last 12 games and has reached base safely in all 17 home games this season.

JHONNY BE GOOD: Jhonny Peralta has hit .340 (18-53) with 5 multi-hit games in the month of May, the 10th highest average this month among N.L. hitters...he snapped a streak yesterday of reaching base safely in 19 straight since April 25 (hits in 17 games, via walk twice)...his .338 batting avg in that span ranks 13th among all MLB players and he is 8th in the NL in Slugging Pct. (.558) in that time frame.

NESHEK ON THE PLUS SIDE: Righty reliever Pat Neshek ranks 2nd on the club with 20 apps. (Siegrist 21) and has a 13.1 IP scoreless streak over his last 15 games, currently the 4th longest streak in the N.L. ...his longest career scoreless string was 16.1 IP for the Twins in 2007...he currently leads the N.L. in relief WHIP (0.57).

JAIME GARCIA • LHP • 6-2 • 215 • 27 yrs • #54

⇒ Is making his first ML appearance & start since 5/17/13 vs. MIL, when he suffered a left shoulder strain which put him out for the rest of the 2013 season.
 ⇒ Had surgery to repair labrum and rotator cuff in late May that was performed by Dr. George Paletta.
 ⇒ This is his 100th career appearance and 91st career start. Looking to win his 40th game (39-25). Will have made 50 home appearances and 50 road appearances.
 ⇒ Made two rehab starts before joining club. The most recent in Memphis (AAA) on 5/12 tossing 5 IP, allowing two runs on three hits with five strikeouts. Had a rehab start shortened in Springfield (AA) on 5/4, tossing 2 IP, allowing two runs on three hits and was removed after getting hit by pitch on left elbow while batting in the 2nd inning.
 ⇒ Has a 2-0 record with a 3.65 ERA over four career starts vs. ATL, and is 2-0 with a 3.38 ERA in three starts vs. ATL at Busch Stadium.
 ⇒ Is 9-4 with a 2.58 ERA vs. NL East opponents over 21 career starts (23 app) covering 129.0 IP.
 ⇒ Has surrendered 7 HR to left-handed batters in his career, six of them are All-Stars (Howard, C. Gonzalez, Freeman, Harper, Bruce, Montero).
 ⇒ Has the 3rd lowest ERA (min. 10 GS) at Busch Stadium III with a 2.66 ERA over 44 career starts (291 IP).
 ⇒ Pitched the 2013 home opener vs. CIN (4/8) and tied his career high with 10 strikeouts.
 ⇒ Led Cardinals pitchers in hits in 2012 with 10. Has two career home runs.
